Course	Description	Dates
<b>Zoom for Beginners</b>	Learn the basic skills needed to participate in online Zoom video meetings which are becoming very popular in both the social and business communities. This training program is intended to help you get started and become comfortable chatting with and seeing the smiles of the family and friends that you miss. <b>Intro to iPads</b>	Participants will learn the physical parts of the iPad, how to take a 'selfie' and common apps.
